ABOUT THE IUOE LOCAL 450 APPRENTICESHIP

The IUOE Local 450 Union apprenticeship and training fund gives you the opportunity to earn while you learn at no cost to you. Our objective is to provide and promote the highest standard of safety and skills training for the next generation of operating engineers. The apprenticeship program covers a three-year period or more to acquire the mandatory 4000 to 6000 hours of paid on-the-job training and the non-paid related classroom instruction of 144 hours per year (432 term) during the program.



WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY?

When turning in an application, you will need to provide your:

- Birth Certificate
- Valid Driver's License
- Social Security Card
- High School Diploma **WITH OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT** **or GED** with official transcript
- DD-214 if applicable
- You must be able to obtain a Class A CDL Driver's License, pass a drug screening, and pass a background check

HOW DOES THE APPLICATION PROCESS WORK?

Applicants must visit the Apprenticeship Training Center at 13285 Hwy 146 S, Dayton, TX 77535 to sign out an application. The Applications will be graded and must score at least 70% to qualify for an interview. Once interviewed, a pre-determined number of applicants will be conditionally accepted.
